SUCCESSES

- Events such as Marhaba, SJRS, Community Cup, Big Half and AAWA Walkathon continue to be well received.
- Gents Padel added to portfolio, basketball continues to grow
- Gents Transition to CRM
- Ladies Appointment of new Trustee & Head of Ladies Sport
- Ladies v. successful Ramadhan Sports Night (first since 2019) and good numbers across ladies sports
- Unity prep has lead to surge in participation and engagement.

CHALLENGES

- Cost of living and hire costs
- Weekly participation and engagement low in some sports (particularly rackets for gents and girls sports for ladies)
- CRM driving higher admin burden
- Gents website has been a challenge

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Gents

- Engagement with SJ Gents Sports Coordinators in early Autumn on timeline and process
- SJ Gents Sports Coordinators submit spreadsheets to SJ Gents EC Team for review
- Challenge by SJ Gents EC team i.e. existing participation numbers, venue costs for next year etc
- Finalised SJ Gents 2024 Budget presentation to Trustees

Ladies

- Populated the weekly sporting calendar for 2024 and the addition/removal of any sports
- SJ Ladies HQ consolidated weekly sports budget assessing participation numbers and coaching requirements
- Determined larger events and initiatives outside weekly sports
- Finalised SJ Ladies 2024 Budget presentation to Trustees

- Membership growth driven by adults (ladies & gents) and gents seniors (50% of total growth).
- 2024 membership income based on 2023 numbers and rates frozen

Gents Sports

- 72% of Gents Sports income is derived from PAYG
- 71 % of Gents expenditure is venue costs
- 83 % of Gents deficit is derived from seniors, youth football (75%), youth badminton and table tennis

Ladies Sports

50% of Ladies Sports income is derived from PAYG with a further 35% driven by Marhaba income (incl sponsors)

- HQ
- Membership frozen for 2024

- 36% of Ladies Expenditure is venue costs with a further 36% driven by Marhaba
- Weekly sports cost neutral. • Deficit from Marhaba, subsidising coaching courses and MAMT
